Procedures for the publication of statements of reviews conducted under section 6A of the Parliamentary Standards Act 2009

1. Where the Compliance Officer conducts a review of a determination made by IPSA in respect of a claim (“the Claim”) made under the MPs’ Expenses Scheme, the Compliance Officer will, in accordance with the Parliamentary Standards Act 2009, provide IPSA with a Statement of the outcome of that review.
2. The Compliance Officer shall, in addition, cause that Statement to be published as soon as practicable after the conclusion of the review.
3. However, no such Statement shall be published if:
 - a. fewer than 28 days have passed since the outcome of the review was notified to the MP who submitted the Claim;
 - b. legal proceedings in relation to the Claim are ongoing and/or not all avenues of appeal in relation to the Claim have been exhausted; or
 - c. in the opinion of the Compliance Officer, other exceptional circumstances justify a decision not to publish the Statement.
